Before Michigan State Shooting, Some Students Survived Sandy Hook and Oxford

The gunfire on Monday night left three dead and five critically injured. For some students, the familiar rituals of sorrow, anger and disbelief were playing out again.

EAST LANSING, Mich. - As gunshots erupted on the vast Michigan State University campus late on Monday, killing three students and injuring five others, many on campus felt a chilling sense of familiarity.

They were just children when the shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Conn., killed 26 students, teachers and staff members in 2012. Nine years later, the Oxford High School shooting in a nearby township outside of Detroit, left four teenagers dead.

Now, as young adults, they had made it to college, and it was taking place all over again.

Wanting to stop sheriff's deputies from carrying out a court-ordered eviction last week, Rorie Woods turned to a "dangerous weapon," authorities said.

Woods allegedly pulled up to the home where the eviction was taking place, got out of her SUV and walked back to the flatbed trailer she had towed to the tony neighborhood in Longmeadow, Mass., a town of nearly 16,000 on the Connecticut state line.

Then, she unleashed hundreds of bees from the hives she had brought, according to the sheriff's office.
